



## COVID-19 Safety Protocols

The Society of Hospital Medicine (SHM) and Society of General Internal Medicine (SGIM) prioritize the safety and well-being of our members, and we recognize the vital role of our members and event attendees on the front lines of care in their communities. To this end, the Academic Hospitalist Academy (AHA) is following guidance provided by [Centers for Disease Control & Prevention \(CDC\)](#), the [World Health Organization \(WHO\)](#), and guidelines issued by the city of Englewood, CO.

## Vaccination & Masking Requirements

**All registered attendees and association staff are required to be fully vaccinated against SARS-CoV-2.** “Fully vaccinated” is defined as a person who has received the full dosage regimen of a vaccine authorized for emergency and/or full use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration or by the World Health Organization, at least two weeks prior to the first day of the event.

We ask that you keep attendees, faculty, and staff in mind as you make decisions about best practices in health and safety. All attendees and association staff are required to wear a mask indoors while they are not actively eating or drinking. Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 should not attend this in-person conference.
